## Question: What are service users' research priorities?

Service users held their own priority-setting workshop day. The aim of the workshop was to select research priorities they identified as important to take forward over the coming year.

Stage 1  
Research questions and ideas generated  
108 in total

Stage 2  
1st round of voting - Service users prioritise 2 ideas or questions from each of the 6 topic areas

Stage 3  
2nd round of voting - Service users select topic they would most like to research

## Findings: How will the group take their findings forward?

The Group will now look for funding to undertake research into the areas of mental health they have identified as important, in line with the priorities chosen.

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1st Priority  
Undertake research in schools and colleges to find out what training they provide to their students regarding mental health, and whether it can be improved.

2nd Priority  
How can education provide a 'Centre of Gravity' to recovery, including support?

3rd Priority  
How are carers supported during the recovery of the person for whom they care?

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
